VOCAL DEPARTMENT AUDITION INFORMATION

Welcome to the Grammy Award-Winning Woodbridge High School Vocal Music Department! We are excited that you have chosen to sing with us in the 2019-2020 school year. Below you will find important information about auditions, what to expect, and what happens once audition results are posted. ***Please note that students will need to attend two days of auditions: one individual and one choir specific. Auditions will be held in the Vocal Music Room at Woodbridge High School (M103) from April 29 - May 9.

Individual appointments lasting approximately 6 minutes. During this time, Mr. Blaney will assess your vocal range, tonal memory, ability to sight-sing, and knowledge of intervals and key signatures. If you are auditioning for Bel Canto or Chamber Singers please come prepared to sing *The Star-Spangled Banner*, beginning at the lyric "And the rockets' red glare..." acapella in the key of your choosing. If you are auditioning for Entertainers or Advanced Entertainers, please come prepared to sing an excerpt, acapella, from one of the songs listed on the AUDITION SONGS page on the Vocal Music Website. If you are auditioning for both Bel Canto or Chamber singers AND Entertainers or Advanced Entertainers, please be prepared to sing both songs. **Please bring your completed and signed audition form.**

Bel Canto Auditions
Music will be posted on the Vocal Music Website under the AUDITIONS tab. Please learn the vocal part that is most comfortable for your voice. All students will be in the room and will sing the song together in quartets with one person on a part (soprano I, soprano II, alto I, alto II). Memorization is not required.

Wednesday, May 8
3:30 PM – 6:00 PM

Entertainer/Advanced Entertainer Auditions
Music will be posted on the Vocal Music Website under the AUDITIONS tab. Please learn the vocal part that is most comfortable for your voice. All students will be in the room and will sing the song together in quartets with one person on a part (soprano, alto, tenor, bass). Memorization is not required. Please also be prepared to learn a brief choreography combination. If you are auditioning for vocal percussion, please learn the voice part that is best suited to your voice and also be prepared to demonstrate your beatboxing skills.

Thursday, May 9
3:30 PM – 5:00 PM

Chamber Singers Auditions
Music will be posted on the Vocal Music Website under the AUDITIONS tab. Please learn the vocal part that is most comfortable for your voice. All students will be in the room and will sing the song together in quartets with one person on a part (soprano, alto, tenor, bass). Memorization is not required.

All students may sign up for Concert Chorale (treble or bass) with no audition required. All students who audition will be placed in either Concert Chorale, Bel Canto, Chamber Singers, Entertainers, or Advanced Entertainers. Placement is based on your audition and previous history/level of participation in the Vocal Music Department if any. Choir placement is at the sole discretion of Mr. Blaney and is not contingent on your desired choir, previous choir placement, or availability in your class schedule. Students whose voices are deemed best suited for each choir will be placed in that choir. Most incoming freshmen begin in Concert Chorale and audition for other choirs as they progress through high school. If you love to sing, we encourage you to audition, do your best, and trust that the placement given is where you are supposed to be.
